4. Confirmation of November 2019 minutes

5. Reports

- 5.1.1 President's Christian Verdicchio
- 1. Consuntivo. Has been audited by Gildo Marveggio and Paolo Aromataris.
- 2. 'Integrativo' Funds. The extra funds were received only on 18 December 2019 and were used to cover Matteo Farina's invoice of \$2,500. The remaining \$1,105 was allocated for the New Arrivals Seminar. Due to the lateness it was not possible to organise a seminar in such short time. Therefore an enquiry was forward to the Italian Consulate asking permission to utilise the funds for the Community Engagement's report translation. Unfortunately no reply was received before the end of the year. Roberto Affortunato was of the opinion that the funds would have to be spent on the project submitted.

Action: the Consul will look into the issue.

Tabled Matteo Farina's quote for the Community Engagement report translation. The quote is accepted, funds to be used will be determined once Com.It.Es. receives a reply from the Consul.

Angela Scarino express bewilderment that the procedure of the Consulate to enquire with MAECI for a matter of a small amount seems trivial that it has to go to the Department in Rome, there should be a more simple process.

Discussion followed whether having a seminar for the new arrivals is still feasible considering a decrease in attendees. Most of them are already informed.

 Com.It.Es Elections for 2021. To be called at the end of the year, around November for lists of candidates, in view of possible elections between April and December 2021.



- 4. Co-Optee Vacancy. Discussion whether the committee is still interested to pursue. Some of the nominees have in the past express not to be interested anymore. Possible candidate to consider is Robert Bria.
 Michael Donato moved for Christian Verdicchio to make contact with Mr. Bria for consideration, seconded by Mark Quaglia, all in favour.
- 5. Consul Welcome Event. The event is organised in conjunction with the State Government who will provide admin support, for Tuesday 10 March at 6pm at the Italian Centre for 100 guests and on invite only. Local funds of \$1000 already approved towards expences; SAIA co-sponsor and Serafino winery is sponsoring the wine.

The Consul informed that he has already received an official invitation from the Premier's office in which the Italian Ambassador Francesca Tardioli also is invited.

Unsure whether this is a different event.

Action: Christian Verdicchio will circulate the preliminary list of invites from the State Government when available.

- 6. Language award.
 - a. UniSA
 - Michael Donato attended the presentation at UniSA and presented the award to a student who has excelled in the Italian course.
 - b. Flinders
 - Flinders is still having issues, they have changed their system and it is no longer possible to create an award and therefore it should no longer be pursued.



Other suggestions were discussed regarding the language award recognition and it was decided that it would be important to award a student from year 12 who received the highest ATAR in Italian, this might encourage more students to study Italian in the State. However this will need to be checked with SACE board.

Action: the idea is accepted in principal and Christian Verdicchio will contact the SACE Board.

Angela Scarino briefly explained how teaching of Italian differ from school to school, or from Catholic school to Public school; foreign language not compulsory in secondary school.
