President report tabled. Highlights:

#### AIRE Project

- o Italian Cuisine week 23 to 29 November. Suggested to hold an 'Aperitivo' applying the same format as last year, venue L'Italy on Thursday on 26 November 2020.
- o Dr. Paula Zito to briefly talk about the importance of the Mediterranean diet.
- o Discussed the possibility to a different venue.
- o Consul confirmed the 70% of the program is confirmed, close to the last year format.

Action: Committee members to put forward a suggestion by Tuesday morning for a different venue for the 'Aperitivo'.



### New Arrivals Seminar

- o Mark Quaglia to contact experts; people are making enquiries about visas and there could be more changes for visa holders.
- o Gianna Vorrasi proposed to look in to addressing restrictions that impacts their visas, borders and movement, work requirement.
- o It is suggested to prepare a Q&A.
- Discussion followed regarding whether to physically host the seminar or have a live broadcast professionally done. It is decided to adopt both options, physical and online.

# o Adelaide Italian Festival 2020 (13 to 22 November) and 2021

- o Tabled proposal for sponsorship. Christian Verdicchio gave a background of the program
- o The organisation is looking for sponsorship and partnership for 2 years.
- Com.lt.Es. consideration to submit a sponsorship and Christian Verdicchio and Michael
   Donato leave the room at 7.35pm as per conflict of interest. The President appoints the
   Treasurer Mr Mark Quaglia to chair this part of the meeting.
- Sponsorship is discussed and for how many years. It is proposed to pay \$3,000 up front for the two years and review next year for funds purpose. Local funds will be used for the sponsorship.

Mark Quaglia moved to sponsor \$3,000.00.= up front for two years and review next year, seconded by Angela Scarino, all in favour.

### 5.1.3 Treasurer's – Mr Mark Quaglia

o Preventivo 2021 submission. Budget submitted and tabled. Com.It.Es. received the new regulation for funds application, Circolare n. 2. A new item has been added for events expenses, this was queried with the Consul whether it must be a Com.It.Es. event or can be a contribution for other's events, e.g. Adelaide Italian Festival. If the latest is confirmed the 'preventivo' will be amended for an addition of \$5,000.

Action: Consul to investigate the matter and inform Com.It.Es. of the outcome.

The Cap. 3106 (President's travel) consist only of the Italian Embassy annual meeting in Canberra as Intercomites 2021 will be held in Adelaide, quotes tabled from Frank Varacalli based on full economy fare. Items listed in the Cap. 3103 (administration) are all operational costs, new language project and printing reports. Regarding the rent, COASIT and Dante intend to stay however separate lease contract will be issued.
