#### 5. Reports

- 5.1.1 President's Dr Christian Verdicchio
- o Ambassador S. E. Francesca Tardioli visit. Positive feedback considering the short notice. The Ambassador has a clear direction on promoting the image of Italy and innovative initiatives. She was particular interested in Com.It.Es.'s projects. Thanked the Consul for co-hosting the event. Angela Scarino added, regarding the Italian language and culture, that the next census will be important on spoken foreign language; in South Australia it is still Italian, but will be interesting to know whether the Italian language presence will still be strong.



# New Arrivals Seminar (Mark Quaglia)

- Proposed to postpone it to March 2021 as the Australian Government will present some changes.
- State changes to DAMA (Designated Area Migration Agreements, a formal agreement between the Australian Government and a regional, state or territory authorities implemented 18 months ago). It was thought it would get more visas as its scheme is to provide access to more overseas workers than the standard skilled migration programs. It enables employers to sponsor skilled overseas workers for positions they are unable to fill with local workers. Questions have been forward to the Prime Minister, more needs to be done, and there was still skills deficiency. The Government has rejigged the DAMA, changed list of skill with mention to ethnic skills but there are many vague points.
- The use of funds from the 'integrativo' received in December 2019 was discussed as it has already being extended to 2020 but unable to organise any seminar because of COVID-19.
   The Consul is of the opinion that the funds should be extended to 2021 for the reasons above.
- o Gianna Vorrasi suggested opening the seminar to those who are not just arrivals.
- Angela Scarino on the ethnic community issue, informed that currently in South Australia, Multicultural Affairs is undertaking a review of its legislation. The reform will set a foundation for new multicultural policy based on the change of the population and recognising the contribution of the diverse communities. Therefore removing Ethnic expression and enforcing the principal for Multiculturalism.

#### Language SACE Award

Received email confirming there is a student deserving of the Italian language Award from Com.It.Es.
