It is proposed to utilise the funds for something that is still useful for the new arrivals e.g. how to help them when they are in Australia or go for a different project altogether. ARIA Association is also exploring work opportunity in South Australia for Italian researchers, scientists, professionals, etc. it could be a project in collaboration with Com.It.Es. Promotion of South Australia as a destination to come could be considered.
